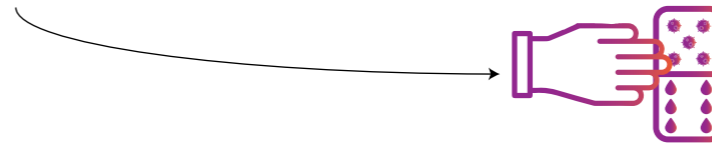


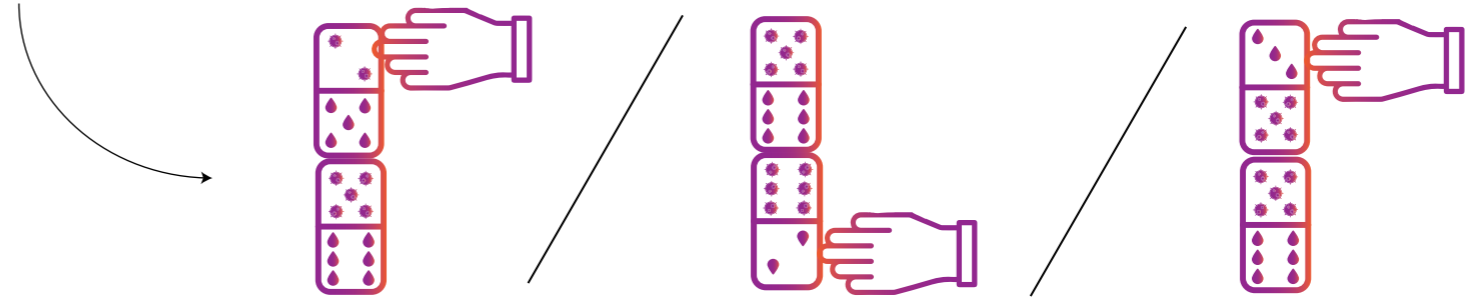
All the players must follow a line of play. If the tiles are set horizontal then play must be horizontal and if vertical then vertical. The line will be changed only by a double tile. it can be kept in all the 4 directions.

## Let's Start to Play the Game!

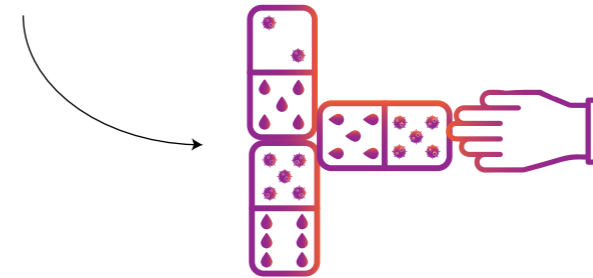
The first player begins by laying their chosen face-up tile in the middle of the table.



The next player must match one of the ends of this Gocoros despite the nibs are different from each other as shown below. You can match Drops with Corona nibs.



Each turn consists of a player laying down the tile. If a double tile is played. It is played perpendicular on the line. If a tile has blank side it can be matched only through blank side.



If the player does not have a tile to play, draw a tile from the draw pile, the Boneyard. If the drawn tile, matches something on the board. You keep playing, if not add this tile to your hand and keep picking the tiles from boneyard.

### How to win?

Whoever is the first to lay down all their tiles is the winner of that round.

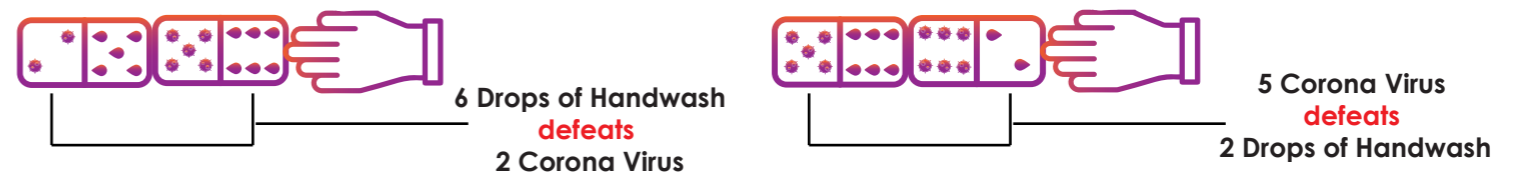
Have the other player add up all the nibs on their tiles in front of them on a piece of paper, add those numbers to the column of the player who won that round.

### It does not end here!

Though the player won the round but he did not win the game. You will have to play a lot of rounds until you win the GAME!

### Twist

•Each time the player plays his turn he has to keep noting down the score of the Corona virus he killed on that turn or got defeated by the virus.



•Keep adding if you defeat the virus and keep subtracting if it defeats you.

### How to win the GOCORO game?

The Score of 150 points is usually called a Game. The player first to score 150 points will win the game and defeat the Evil Corona Army.

## The Game:

### Storyplay:

In the world of Magic and Hope, an army of deadly evil, called Corona virus took over the world spreading death. The Corona army plans to end the worls but little did they know a League of Heroes are waiting to defeat them. Heroes realised they are outnumbered by the Corona army. So they take help of their own people by teaching them the powers to defeat the evil. A power so strong, Drops of the magnificent Handwash and Force sheild to maintain Social distancing. In the battle of Corona Virus Vs the League of Heroes, who will win?

### Game Play:

The game is played using a set of rectangular tiles, called Gocoros. Each Gocoro is rectangle that is divided with a line down in the middle to seperate each end into two squares, one end is corona and other end is a drop of Handwash. And the numer of these corona and drops of handwash are called Nibs.

### What do you need?

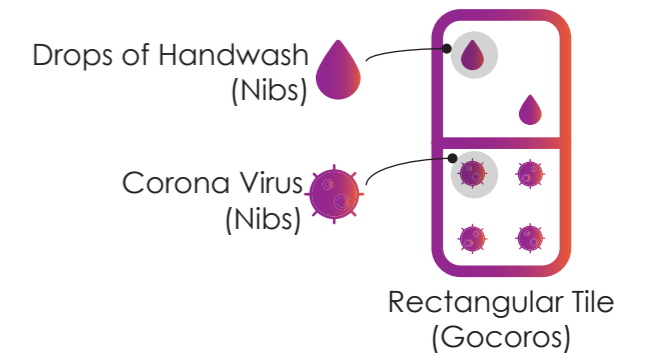
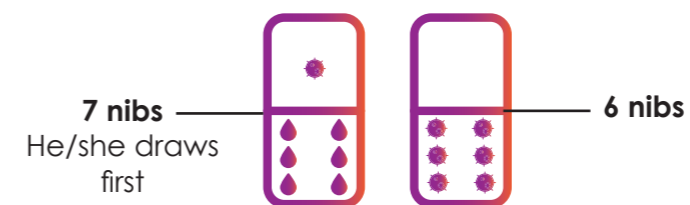
The Gocoro tiles ( A set of 28 tiles)  
A Flat table  
A paper  
A pencil

### Number of players?

2-5 players  
If the number of players increase, take another set to play.

### Who goes First?

Each player draws a Gocoro tile, and the player with Higher number of nibs is the first to play and the round continues Clockwise.



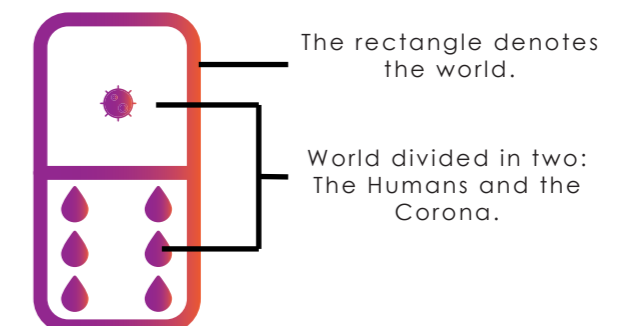
### Game Preparation:

- Place all the tiles facing down. Each Player then draws seven gocoros for his/her hand.
- You can pick from anywhere in the pile but after the tile has been picked it can't be put back in the pile.
- The remaining tiles are used as the draw pile and is known as Boneyard.
- These are left face down on the table to be drawn later if player is unable to play his hand.
- Set the tiles in front of you so the other player does not see them. Keep them Hidden.

28 Gocoro Tiles

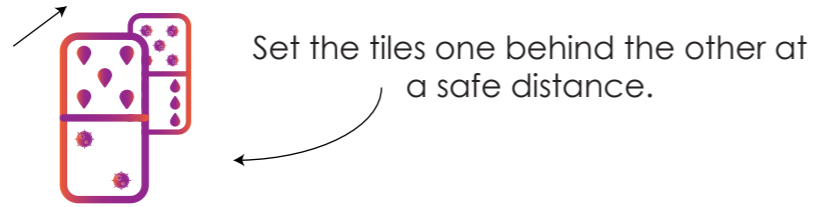
**Number of Players:**

**Age:** +10 years and above

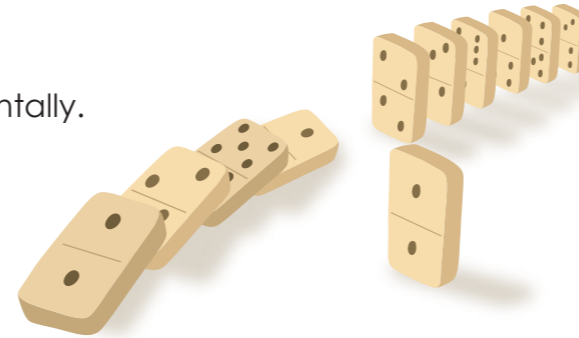
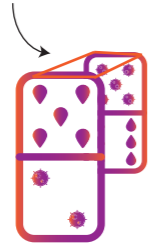


## Alternative Game:

The game can be played vertically and the same rules apply only this time the players must match the tile of the above square nibs.



If the player plays a double tile, the player must place the tile above the other tile horizontally.



Here, the scoring is same but the players need to play collectively, if the tiles fall the whole round will be terminated and the Evil will win.

## Impact:

- The players are educated that drops of handwash can defeat the the corona virus. So, wash the hands.
- The players learn to maintain social distancing, via the vertical game.
- Quality time with your Family.
- Scores will keep you engaged in the game.
